Here is your Invitation to help <u>Care & Prepare</u> fund our newest ideas on the drawing board: "Choose your Champion!" and "ACP Benefit for All!"

Healthcare status can change in an instant. We have all seen catastrophic injury or illness sideline even the healthiest among us. **COVID** has only heightened the demand for our services. Unfortunately, we have a death averse culture, so dying and end of life care issues are rarely discussed, even with some terminally ill patients. This is not an acceptable standard of care.

<u>Care & Prepare</u> volunteers have served the community for 20+ years with this in mind: **Our Vision:** To foster a culture in which All people live well All their days. **Our Mission:** To stimulate end of life care conversations through education.

Care & Prepare (C&P) had just begun a new step in our strategic plan when COVID hit. I am happy to report that we are undeterred from our mission and have used this occasion to reach out via <u>webinars</u> to large groups who need our information.

Care & Prepare participated in a study that was reported in <u>JAMA Network May 2020</u>. The research question was: "Can a low-cost, easily scaled, end-of-life conversation game motivate underserved African American individuals to engage in advance care planning (ACP)?" The answer was "Yes!" but currently, less than 25% of **BIPOC** (Black, Indigenous and people of color) have ACP planning. Hence, they are less likely to have their medical care wishes known and honored.\(\frac{1}{2}\)

Currently, the **minority community is suffering greatly** from **COVID** and we grieve with them. However, we believe we are developing a **sustainable model** for reaching the BIPOC community with a compelling Advance Care Planning message: "**Choose your Champion!**" • **which is part** of an ambitious **new project** on the drawing board: "**ACP Benefit for All**". Funding for this pilot project* as well as wise counsel for our Board will assist us in making this effort sustainable.
